On Monday, the Mayor of Calderdale visited Beech Hill School to hear a presentation by 80 children, aged 4-5, regarding concerns they have about their local environment.

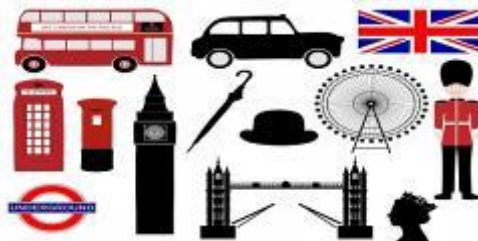
The Mayor, Councillor Howard Blagborough, was accompanied by Dave Dunbar, Senior Environmental Health Officer, and both listened attentively to the children who showed them photographs and a map of the area which highlighted key problems of waste dumping, graffiti and dog excrement.

The Mayor was impressed by their project and enthusiasm for wanting to improve the locality.

He said "The children talked about a local play area which is not safe for them to use because of broken glass and other waste. I told them that I shared their concerns and would make enquiries, on their behalf, about how the situation could be improved".
