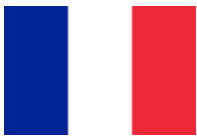

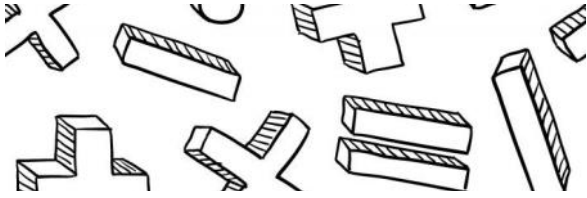
The miscalculation of Captain Half Inch

This was a show about pirates and it was linked to maths.

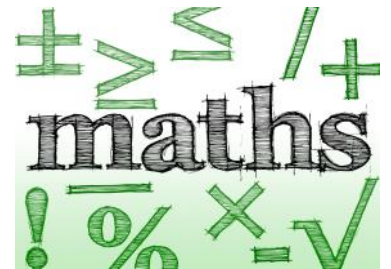
The two performers asked us lots of questions on how to solve different problems such as column addition, rounding and fractions.
