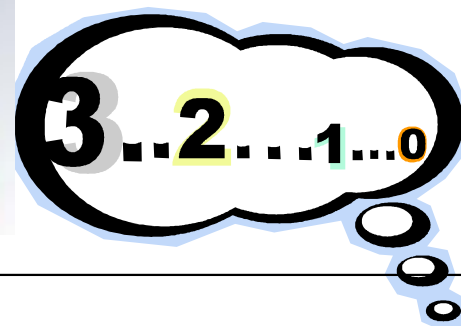

S7 Soccer Academy

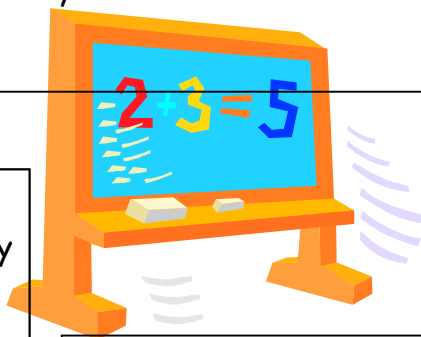
