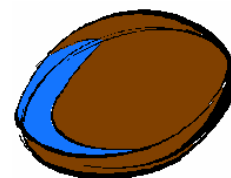


Football, St Malachys

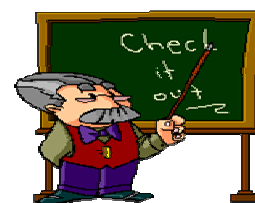
