The money raised will go towards the PTA funds.

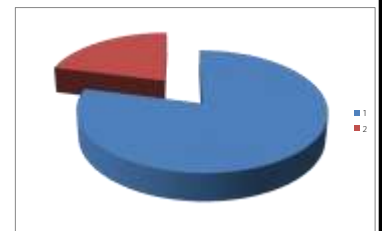
This scheme has now closed and any more bags cannot be accepted.
