Please use a hard boiled egg shell to submit your design.

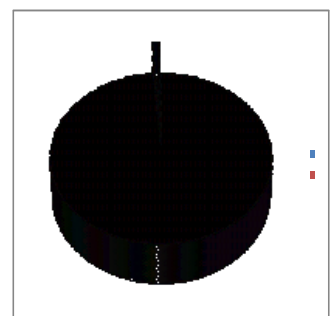
