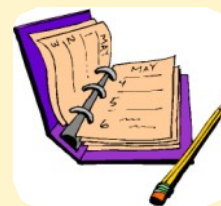
A huge well done to Class 5 the KS1 winners with 98.3%. Well done class 5.

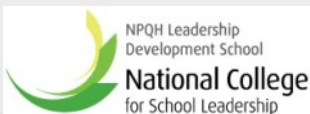
