We apologise for cancelling Parents Evening, we will re-schedule the evening at our earliest opportunity. Thank you for your patience and support.



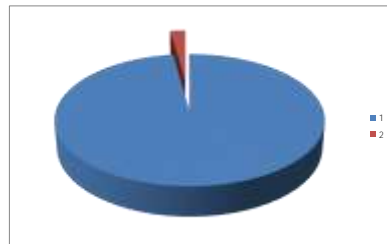
