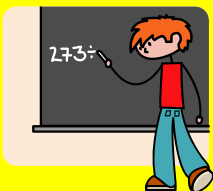

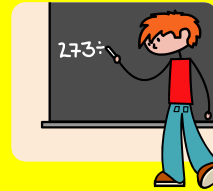

Beech Hill School Uniform

As many parents will be buying new uniform during the holidays we would like to remind you of our school uniform. Below is a list of items children are permitted to wear as part of school uniform.

Boys:

- Green sweatshirt or jumper with school logo.
- White shirt/polo shirt.
- Grey trousers.

Girls:

- Green sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan with logo.
- Grey trousers /skirt with white leggings.
- Grey, or green shalwar kameez.
- Green and white checked dress with white Leggings.
- Headscarves may be worn in grey, white or green.

Jewellery is not permitted due to health and safety reasons. We do however, allow one pair of plain studs which the children must be able to remove for P.E.
