## Attendance

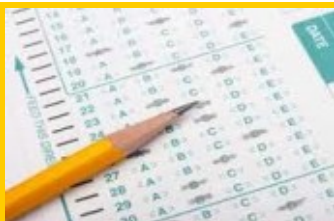
Our whole school percentage the week before the holidays was just below our target of 94%. The attendance figures always seem to dip before and after a holiday.
