

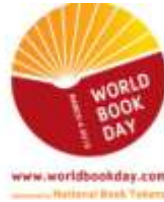

World Book Day: Assembly



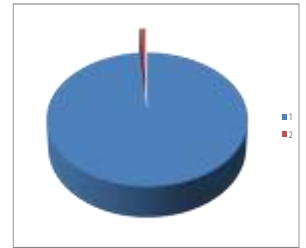

Beech Hill Morning Club

The Beech Hill Morning Club enables parents / carers to drop off children at school from 7.30am onwards every day in term time. Your child will receive high quality childcare plus a cooked breakfast.

Members of the existing school staff have been employed to look after your child and a range of fun learning activities will be provided for them.

There is a charge of 50p per child each morning which is payable in advance at the beginning of each half term, for the entire term. This charged will be applied even if your child misses a session as we need to cover the cost of employing additional members of staff.

The Morning Club is a response to requests from parents for extended hours enabling them to return to work or education. As you will appreciate, in order to run it effectively, the school needs a regular commitment to provide the level of staffing which ensures that your child has the best possible experience.
