Headteacher Meeting with PTA



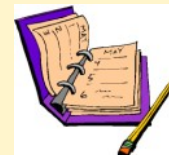
Our Headteacher would like to invite all parents and carers to discuss any school topics or issues on **Friday 25th November**, immediately after Gold Book Assembly.
