<p><u>Challenge 1- Writing</u></p> <p>Write a diary entry of the most exciting days of your holiday. We have written a diary in class this half term, so think carefully about the features you need to include.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 2- Reading</u></p> <p>Read your reading book out loud every day for at least 10 minutes. When reading, think about your reading fluency by ensuring that you are using expression, pausing for punctuation and reading accurately at the correct pace.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 3- Times tables</u></p> <p>Practise your target times table every day for at least 10 minutes, by saying them out loud, writing them down in the correct order and answering questions which are jumbled up.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 4- The Arts</u></p> <p>Use your learning log, research to creatively present your knowledge of the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age. You could write a poem, sing a song or create a piece of music, create a piece of artwork or some drama.</p>
<p><u>Challenge 5- Handwriting</u></p> <p>Copy a paragraph of your reading book in your neatest handwriting, making sure to spell all the words correctly and use joined, cursive handwriting.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 6- Spellings</u></p> <p>Carefully copy out the Year 3 and 4 common exception words until you know them. Test yourself on the words or ask an adult to test you.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 7- Writing</u></p> <p>Write a book review about your reading book or create a book review book snap on Seesaw.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 8- Reading</u></p> <p>Choose a book from your house or the library that you enjoy reading or want to read, and read it for pleasure. You may want to read it to a member of your family or to yourself.</p>
<p><u>Challenge 9- Maths</u></p> <p>Practise your maths knowledge by using Hit the Button (number bonds and times tables), the Times Tables Rock stars app or completing the multiplication quiz on Seesaw.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 10- RE</u></p> <p>Think about the communities you belong to and write or draw why they are important to you.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 11- Science</u></p> <p>Use non-fiction books or the internet to find out about our new science unit - Sound - and create an informative poster about it.</p>	<p><u>Challenge 12- SMSC</u></p> <p>Write about how you showcase one of Beech Hill's core values - see website/Seesaw.</p>
