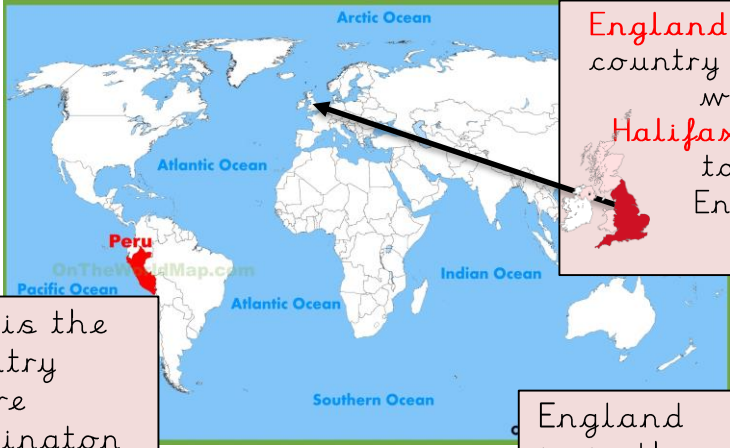




Autumn Term 1 - Paddington's Adventures



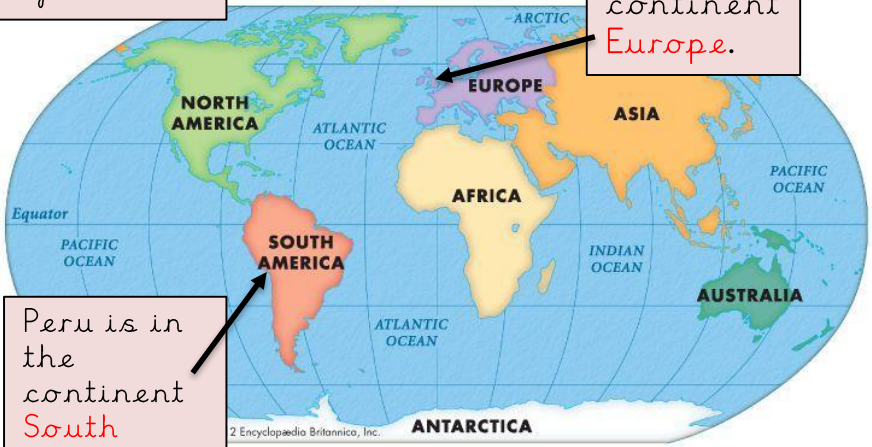
Map of the World



England is the country where we live.

Atlas	An atlas is a non-fiction book with different maps.
Map	A map is a drawing of an area. Its basic purpose is to show where things are. Maps may show features such as rivers and roads. Maps use symbols to show where certain things are.
Local Area	Local area is the area that you live in (Halifax).
Aerial View	The word aerial means from above. When we look at something from above we call this an 'aerial view'.
Continent	The continent is made up of lots of countries. There is seven continents in the world.
Country	A country is a piece of land inside a continent. People live in countries.
Town	An area in a country where people live.
Globe	A globe is a sphere model of the earth. It shows you where different countries are in relation to each other.
Key	A key is used on a map to give meaning behind symbols and colours used as representations.
