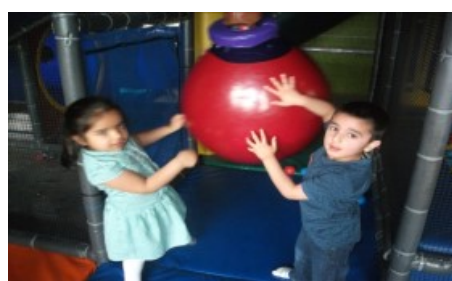
Young First Aiders

Here are some of the skills and knowledge that we learnt in the lesson. If we see a person injured on the floor, the procedure we should follow is DRAB. This stands for: Danger, Response, Airway and Breathing. In case the DRAB does not work, the next step is the recovery position and it is only used for a person who is unconscious. We also learnt what to do if a person was choking and the process of CPR if someone wasn't breathing.

Dear Year 3,



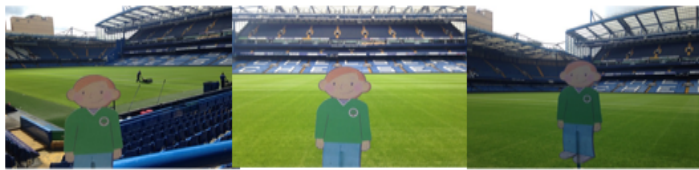
