Out of school & Day care provision

Beech Hill is very excited to offer the following day care provision. An out of school club will run from 7.30am to 8.45am each morning; and from the end of the school day, 3.10pm to 5.30pm each evening. Sessions will all include a healthy snack and drink for the children to enjoy at their leisure.

2 -3 year old Paid full-time /part-time places

In addition to the 15 hour funded places, Beech Hill is now offering childcare for 2-4 years olds. This can be for mornings or afternoon sessions or for full days from 8.45am to 3.10pm and can also include breakfast club and afterschool care. Children accessing the dinnertime session at Beech Hill will be provided with a hot school dinner.
