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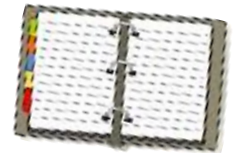


Beech Hill School is pleased to announce that we have achieved the Bronze Level in the National School Travel Awards, Modeshift Stars!
