Due to the building work that has now started in the Beech Hill area, we would be grateful if parents would refrain from parking on Mount Pleasant Avenue. Over the last few days police officers and traffic enforcement officers have been present at the top of Mount Pleasant Avenue to try and discourage parents from driving down Mount Pleasant Avenue. There have been a number of cars that have been seen turning around by the entrance gates. This is extremely dangerous as all of our children and parents enter and leave the school site through this area. Please think about the safety of our pupils and avoid the risk of injuring someone through reckless driving.

From Monday, the school in line with the Travel Plan will be opening up the gate on Pellon Lane by the football pitch. We would like Year 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and Fiji class to be entering the school through this gate and following the path around to the main playground. This will mean that only Nursery, Reception and Year 1 pupils in Class New Zealand and Portugal will need to walk down Mount Pleasant Avenue.

We would encourage parents to park in Aldi car park and walk safely down the path from Pellon Lane into the playground. This is a much safer route for the everyone.
