Child safety in cars

Does your child have or need a car seat? UK law states that children must use a child car seat until they are 12 years old or 135cm / 4ft 5in tall, whichever comes first.



The law states children aged 12 or 13 years old, or younger and over 135cm tall can wear a seat belt. Please remember that the driver of the vehicle is responsible for ensuring all passengers are safely strapped in. If you're the driver, always check.

Try some of these ideas to provide a healthy packed lunch at school.


Get your five a day - Fruit
