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Healthy Lunchboxes

It is important that your child/children have a healthy lunch to sustain them throughout the day. Healthy Lunchbox Ideas:

Wholemeal sandwiches with tuna, mayo and cucumber.

Pasta twirls with tomato and vegetable sauce.

Brown/white rice salad with tinned tuna, tomatoes, cucumber & spring onion.

Small pot of humus with wholemeal/white pitta, or breadsticks and chopped cucumber, peppers, carrots, celery, cherry tomatoes.

Tuna or chicken or egg salad with lots of crunchy vegetables.

Parking around school


Girl's Football
