Important Notice

PARKING UPDATE As you are aware, we are working to introduce Resident Permit Zones to Beech Hill to address parking problems in the area. Initial consultations have taken place with residents for approval to develop a scheme, a brief has been issued to the delivery team, a draft design has been produced and the emergency services have been consulted.

Highways currently have three months of the statutory consultation period still to complete. Subject to final approval of the scheme, parking services will require a further 6-8 weeks to issue notices, process applications and issue permits. We are hoping the zones will be in place by October.

However, factors such as objections leading to design changes and the need to go back out to consultation, could cause delays.
