## FIREWORKS & THE LAW

Calderdale Council and its partners West Yorkshire Fire Service and West Yorkshire Police are keen to support local residents in celebrating festivities and family events.

Whilst celebrating these festivities and family events please bear in mind that you have an obligation to respect your local neighbourhood.

Information has come to light that fireworks are being used in the early hours of the morning to celebrate family weddings etc , these can be disruptive to residents in the immediate and neighbouring area. This can also impact pets as well.

The Law states you must NOT set off fireworks between 11pm and 7am , except for:

- ⇒ Bonfire Night , when the cut off is midnight
- ⇒ New Year's Eve , Diwali and Chinese New Year , when the cut off is 1am

You can be fined up to £5,000 and imprisoned for up to 6 months for selling or using fireworks illegally. You may also receive an on the spot fine of £90.
