On Friday 6th March, we had a fantastic time celebrating World Book Day! Children and staff dressed up as characters from their favourite books and took part in different reading activities throughout the morning.

This year we are supporting World Book Day's **Share a Million Stories campaign**, championing the importance of sharing stories and for the chance to win £1000 of books for our school. Sharing a story for just 10 minutes a day can have a lasting impact of a child's future, and can help to create readers for life. On Friday, each child received their **Share a Million Stories Reading Record**.
