

## Shape of the Week



This 2D shape is a circle. A circle is a 2D shape with 1 curved side. It has no vertices. The distance all the way around the circle is called the circumference. The distance from the centre to the edge is the radius. The distance all the way from one side to the other going through the centre is the diameter.



This 2D shape is a semi circle. It is exactly half of a circle. It has 2 sides - 1 straight and 1 curved.

## Y4 Stone Age Workshop
