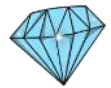

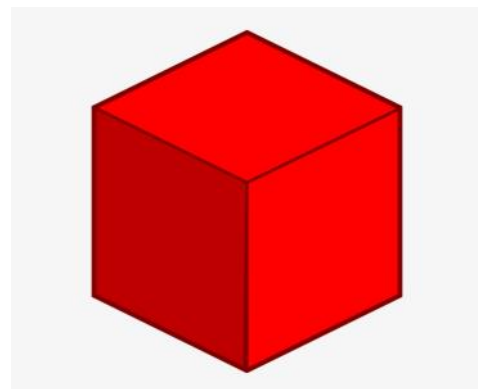


Shape of the Week - Cube

It is a polyhedron

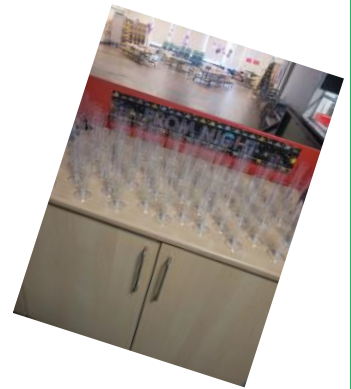


Y6 Prom
