Harvest Festival

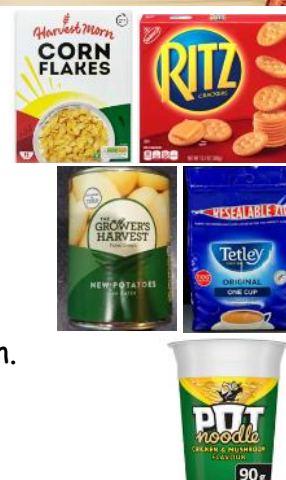
Once again, we will be holding a Harvest Festival at school; this is a celebration of food that is grown on land.

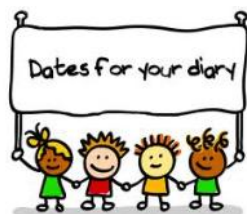
